Worship Guide: Making Sense of the Psalter

In Psalm 43, we not only hear the pleadings of the Psalmist as he desires deliverance and refuge from those who oppress the godly (v. 1-2), we also gain a better understanding of the agony of Jesus Christ as

He labors in prayer on that night. For it is in Gethsemane that we see His true soul downcast and disquieted within Him anticipating what is to come (v. 5), but at the same time looking with expectation to the results of His righteous work for Himself and those whose sin He bore (vv. 3-4).
