Worship Guide: Making Sense of the Psalter

The LORD is good and merciful – “*let the redeemed of the LORD say so*” This is what the psalmist in Psalm 107:1-16 calls we, who have experienced His *wondrous works to man*, to recall (v. 1-3, 8, 15). Those once formerly wearied from their wandering from God (v. 4-5), who cried out to Him, let these give thanks to the Lord for restoring them and satisfying them with a home (v. 6-9). For those once imprisoned

because of their rebellion against the almighty (*vv. 10-12*), who cried out to Him, let these remember and give thanks for the great work that He alone wrought through the only Redeemer of mankind, Jesus Christ, who broke their chains and led them out from under the cruel bondage of sin (*vv. 13-16*).
