Worship Guide: Making Sense of the Psalter

Psalm 119:17-24 finds the psalmist asking the Lord to be exceedingly good to him, by granting grace to keep His Word. For the psalmist is reminded that he is like one who is utterly unfamiliar with his surroundings, and that he will perish unless the Lord shows him the path of life (vv. 17-19). For he is regularly crushed down with those who despise the Word – unless the Lord in His mercy rescues His faithful one from condemnation (vv. 20-22); He is weighed down under the oppression of godless rulers – unless the Lord comforts him and makes his delight the Word of God (vv. 23-24). May these inspired Words convey our hearts this morning as we joyfully worship our *Wonderful Counselor*, Jesus Christ – *the Word of God made flesh*, who has fulfilled this Word and by it leads our steps aright (v. 24).
