### **Worship Guide: Making Sense of the Psalter**

The Psalmist, from the depths of his parched soul in Psalm 42:1-5, comes feebly into the presence of the living God asking for strength (vv. 1-2). For while he formerly enjoyed the refreshment of the fellowship of believers, as of late he has only fed on the despair he experiences as he witnesses the covenant community’s rising rejection of her LORD (vv. 3-4). However, even in the midst of his depression, we see the Psalmist rebuking his downcast soul, and demanding that it rise up and give praise to He who is *his* gracious God: who is always *his* help (v. 5). May we, who know “*Christ in you, the hope of glory*” (*Colossians 1:27*), likewise resolve to meet our own trying times in the same manner.
