PRELUDE

PRAYER OF THE DAY

Speak to us this morning and give us the words that all can understand when we tell of your story and your grace. In Jesus' holy name, Amen.

Leader: God makes people strong. God gives people peace.

CALL TO CONFESSION

The separation we feel from God's Spirit is not our ultimate reality. For times we dehumanize our neighbor instead of loving them.
Forgive us. For times we serve powers and principalities rather than you, our Servant Savior. For selectively hearing your good news of grace for us without considering the same for others. Forgive us.
For seeing ourselves less than the full person you created in beauty with delight. Forgive us and grant us peace.**

ASSURANCE OF PARDON *(from John 3:16-17)*

Leader: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world but in order that the world might be saved through him.
